# Health Safety Measures



**Measure 1:** The immediate suspension is ordered, from March 30 to April 30, 2020 for non essential activities in the public, private and social sectors, with for the purpose of mitigating the spread and transmission of the Virus SARS-CoV-2 in the community, to diminish the effects of the disease, its complications and death by COVID-19 in the population resident in the national territory.

# Health Safety Measures



The following are considered essential activities for this measure:

**Measure 1 Subparagraph a):** Those persons that are directly necessary for attending to the health contingency, such as the work activities in the medical, paramedical, and administrative sectors and support in all the public and private sectors. As well as to those who participate in the supply, services and procurement chains, including those provided by the pharmaceuticals industry both in production and in distribution (pharmacies); the manufacturing of materials, medical equipment and technologies for the health care, as well as those involved in the proper disposal of all infectious biological hazardous wastes (RPBI), as well as the cleaning and sanitization of the medical units in the different levels of attention.

# Health Safety Measures



The following are considered essential activities for this measure:

**Measure 1 Subparagraph b):** Those involved in public safety and the protection of citizens; in the defense of integrity and national sovereignty; the procurement and imparting of justice, as well as legislative activity at the federal and state levels.

# Health Safety Measures



The following are considered essential activities for this measure::

**Measure 1, paragraph c):** The sectors considered as essential to the basic functioning of the economy: financial, tax collection, distribution and sale of energy, gas stations and natural gas, the generation and distribution of potable water, food industry and non - alcoholic beverages, food markets, supermarkets, convenience stores, groceries and sale of prepared foods; passenger and cargo transportation services; agriculture and livestock production, agribusiness, chemicals, cleaning products; hardware stores, courier services, guards in private security work; nurseries and day care centers, nursing homes and old age homes, telecommunications and information media, private emergency services, funeral and the burial services, storage and chain of essential materials, logistics (airports, ports and railways), as well as activities whose suspension may have irreversible effects for its continuation.

# Health Safety Measures



The following are considered essential activities for this measure:

**Measure 1 Subparagraph d):** The operation of the social programs of the government..

**Measure 1 Subparagraph e):** The conservation and maintenance of critical infrastructure to ensure the production and distribution of services essential as being those of: potable water, electricity, natural gas, oil, gasoline, jet fuel, basic sanitation, public transport, hospital infrastructure and medical first level infrastructure, and others more that could be defined under this category.

# Health Safety Measures



**Measure 2:** In all the sectors and activities defined as essential, the following actions must be mandatorily applied: not conduct meetings or congregate more than 100 people, frequently washing hands, sneezing or coughing applying good respiratory manners, greeting at a distance (no kissing, handshakes or hugs) and all other current healthy distancing measures in force and issued by the Federal Secretary of Health.

## Health Safety Measures



**Measure 3:** The entire population residing in the territory of Mexico, including those that arrive from Mexico from another country, and that does not participate in essential labor activities to comply with responsible shelter at home from the March 30 to April 30, 2020. Shelter at home is understood as the voluntary limitation of movement, staying at home the greater part of the time as possible.



## Health Safety Measures



**Measure 4:** The immediate responsible shelter at home is to be applied strictly to any person older than 60 years of age or with a diagnosis of hypertension, diabetes, cardiac or pulmonary disease, immunosuppression (acquired or induced), pregnant or nursing, regardless of whether their work activity is considered essential. The staff essential to the public interest may voluntarily present themselves for work.

## Health Safety Measures



**Measure 5:** Once the suspension of non essential activities and the shelter at home comes to an end, the Secretary of Health, in agreement with the Secretary of Economy and the Secretary of Labor, will issue the guidelines for the staggered and regionalized return to labor, economic and social activities, of the entire population of Mexico.

## Health Safety Measures



**Measure 6:** Until further notice all the electoral processes, censuses and surveys to be carried on the national territory, which involved the mobilization of people and the physical interaction (face to face) between the same must be delayed.

**Measure 7:** All measures must be applied with strict respect and adherence to human rights.
